

WHAT IS "PrEP"?

PrEP stands for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis, a therapy to take before exposure to reduce the risk of contracting HIV. It consists of a combination of antiviral drugs, and today we know it is one of the best ways to stop the spread of HIV!

IS Prep really effective?

PrEP is highly effective to prevent HIV infection when taken as prescribed by a physician.

IS PrEP SAFE?

PrEP is generally well-tolerated, and no serious side effects have been observed. It may in some cases have mild adverse effects that usually resolve with time. While taking PrEP, screening of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and blood tests are performed to ensure that the prophylaxis works in complete safety.

IS PrEP SUITABLE FOR ME?

PrEP can help protect you and is recommended if you are in one of these situations:

- you have multiple partners
- vou don't always use or haven't always used a condom
- you have been diagnosed a STI in the past six months
- you have been prescribed PrEP in the past
